From Pastor Tia

Greetings Friends, We all have favorite passages in the Bible. Mine are ones that Jesus speaks, and I have been thinking about them a lot recently. My number one is quoted in Matthew, Mark and Luke's gospels. Jesus is responding to a guestion asked by a religious authority of the time. Jesus said to him. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets." Matt. 22:37-40

The second passage is one my Nana and Mother quoted to me often, "The Golden Rule." This is also Jesus' words: "In everything do to others as you would have them do to you ..." Matt. 7:12

I mention these two passages because of the polarizing climate we are experiencing in our country, really the world right now. How should we as faithful followers of Jesus Christ respond? How should we navigate these waters with friends, family, church family, etc.?

There are those in different states who think posting the 10 Commandments will do the trick or making children study the Bible in school will make all the difference. When Jesus is asked about the greatest commandment, he answers with one we can all agree on: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."


